## PARENT INFORMATION SESSIONS



# COVID UPDATE

*(Please note that this information is relevant at the time of publication and is liable to change)*

Creaney Primary School has no known positive cases of COVID-19 in the school at the time of publishing this newsletter.

## VISITORS ON THE SCHOOL SITE

Visitors to the school site are required to wear a mask. All visitors should report as normal to the school's front office. Contractors and people working with students on a regular basis will need to sign in using our Passtab system and present their proof of vaccination at the time. Parents do not need to show proof of vaccination to pick up and drop off children.

Parents are required to wear a mask when entering the school grounds and socially distance from others.

## LIMITING LARGE GATHERINGS

At the direction of the Chief Health Officer, schools have been advised to limit the number of people gathering in an area of the school. As such, our parent information sessions scheduled for this week have been cancelled. Teachers will communicate the information they were going to provide to you via Seesaw and a hard copy of the information teachers were going to give out at the meeting will be sent home with one child from each family.

At this stage, our first large event, our Student Council assembly, will not go ahead until we can seek further clarification around these sorts of gatherings. It may be that we are able to have our students meet in smaller groups or cohorts but it is unlikely that parents will be invited in the short term.

## MASK REQUIREMENTS

Parents continue to be allowed onto school grounds to pick up and drop off their child/ren. Please wear a mask when doing so.

Parents are no longer permitted in classrooms unless a one-on-one parent meeting is taking place after hours. Teachers have been requested to hold phone or online interviews instead.

Unfortunately, parent helpers and volunteers in classrooms will not be permitted.

## WHAT HAPPENS IF THERE IS A POSITIVE CASE OF COVID-19

The Department of Education, at the direction of the Chief Health Officer may close the school, a classroom or a cluster of rooms if there is a recorded positive case of COVID-19. Depending on the circumstances, the school may be closed for 7 days whilst contact tracing and isolation occurs.

The Chief Health Officer is the only person who can instruct a school to close and each case will be taken on its merits. The aim of the Department of Education is for schools to remain open to as many students as possible.

## HOW WILL MY CHILD LEARN

Our school has a plan should we need to go into a 'learning from home' situation. The main tool of communication for Creaney PS is Seesaw. This platform enables us to communicate with families should we need to keep you updated. A program of work will be provided for your child should we go into a 'lockdown' situation.

Information on preparing for home learning (for parents) is available on our school website.

## WHAT IF I WANT TO KEEP MY CHILD OFF SCHOOL BECAUSE I AM CONCERNED?

Teachers are not required to provide work for students in two modes e.g. teach the classroom program for students who are at school and provide work for students at home.

If your child is unwell, they are not expected to complete school work, they should rest and recover. If you are keeping siblings home as a precaution, a work package may be provided for your child. This may not be identical to what is being provided in the classroom.

You can visit the Department of Education's Connected Learning Hub should you wish to provide work for your child.

Please keep your child home if they are unwell.

## CLEANING

Our school has extra cleaners employed each day to ensure high-touch surfaces such as desks, drink fountains, toilets and door-knobs are cleaned and sanitised. Should a positive case of COVID-19 be recorded in the school, a 'deep clean' will occur whilst the school is in isolation.

We have hand sanitiser available in every classroom. Students are reminded regularly to wash their hands and sanitise.
